

APRIL 2, 1958

Pursuant to a call by the Mayor the City Council met in Special Session in the Council Chambers on April 2, 1958 for the purpose of considering a selection of Chief of Police. There were present at said Meeting: John B. Rogers, Mayor; Councilmen Freeman, Foote, Johnson, Petersen. Also present: Roy C. Barnes, City Clerk; Art Smith, City Attorney.

After considerable study and review of all applicants, it was moved by Councilman Freeman, seconded by Johnson, that Mr. A. Lowell Cramer be appointed as Chief of Police, and F. G. Perrin as Assistant Chief on a temporary three months basis, effective April 15, 1958. Roll call as follows: Ayes, 4; No, None; carried.

The City Clerk asked the opinion of the Council as to the disposition of the Idaho Falls Baseball Club electric bill. In view of the fact that it appeared to be uncollectible, it was moved by Councilman Freeman, seconded by Johnson, that it be charged off. Roll call as follows: Ayes, 4; No, None; carried.

Mr. Cramer then appeared before the Council and a general discussion followed, relative to the formulation of future policy as pertains to duties of the Chief of Police.

There being no further business, it was moved by Councilman Johnson, seconded by Petersen, that the Council adjourn. Carried.
