

MARCH 28, 1958

Pursuant to a call by the Mayor, the City Council met in Special Session in the Council Chambers on Friday, March 28, 1958, at 11:45 A.M. for the purpose of selecting the successful bidder on the 17<sup>th</sup> Street bridge project. Present: Mayor John B. Rogers; Councilmen Foote, Johnson, Petersen. Absent: Councilman Freeman. Also present: Roy C. Barnes, City Clerk.

On March 26, 1958, at the hour of 8:30 P.M. a Special Meeting had been called for the purpose of opening sealed bids on the 17<sup>th</sup> Street bridge. There being no quorum present, an Official Meeting could not be held. However, the bids were opened by the City Clerk and the Mayor announced to those present that said bids would be referred to the Councilmen and the City Engineer as soon as possible. The Councilmen then studied said bids which revealed the following:

It was moved by Councilman Petersen, seconded by Foote, that the low bid of \$40,208.05, submitted by Goodwin Construction Company be accepted. Roll call as follows: Ayes, 3; No, None; carried.

There being no further business, it was moved by Councilman Petersen, seconded by Johnson, that the Council adjourn. Carried.
