

MARCH 5, 1958

Pursuant to a call by the Mayor, the City Council met in Special Session in the Council Chambers on Wednesday, March 5th, 1958, at 10:00 A.M. for the purpose of considering the re-routing of the sewer trunk line; also to obtain authority to publish request for bids on the 17th Street Bridge. Present: Mayor John B. Rogers; Councilmen Foote, Johnson, Petersen. Absent: Councilman Freeman. Also present: Roy C. Barnes, City Clerk; Don Ellsworth, Asst. City Engineer; Donald F. Lloyd, Engineer for the firm of Cornell, Howland, Hayes, and Merryfield.

Mr. Lloyd asked for approval and authority for a minor re-routing of the sewer line. After considerable discussion it was agreed to change it from along Sunnyside Road to St. Clair Road and then north on St. Clair Road to the approximate center of Section 29, thence north through the approximate center of Section 29 to the approximate center of the section.

The Mayor requested authority to have the City Clerk publish bids for the 17th Street Bridge. It was moved by Councilman Foote, seconded by Johnson, that said authority be granted. Roll call as follows: Ayes, 3; No, None; carried.

It was then moved by Councilman Johnson, seconded by Petersen, that the Council adjourn. Carried.
