

JANUARY 17, 1958

The City Council of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, met in Regular Session, Friday, January 17, 1958, at 8:00 P.M. in the Council Chambers at Idaho Falls, Idaho. Present: Mayor John B. Rogers; Councilmen Foote, Johnson, Petersen, Freeman. Absent: none. Also present: Roy C. Barnes, City Clerk; Art Smith, City Attorney; Claud Black, City Engineer; T. R. Peters, Purchasing Agent.

Minutes of the Recessed Meeting held January 8, 1958, and the minutes of a Special Meeting held January 13, 1958, were read and approved as amended.

The following application for a bartenders permit was presented to-wit: Homer Mayberry, Happy Jacks. It was moved by Councilman Johnson, seconded by Petersen, that the permit be granted. Roll call as follows: Ayes, 4; No, None; carried.

The following soft drink license applications were presented to-wit: W. R. Harward, B.P.O.E. #1087; Howard Knapp, Hiway Market; T. F. Ellis, Ellis Grocery. It was moved by Councilman Johnson, seconded by Petersen, that the licenses be granted. Roll call as follows: Ayes, 4; No, None; carried.

The following Meat Market license applications were presented, to-wit: Hiway Market, Howard Knapp; Ellis Grocery, T. F. Ellis. It was moved by Councilman Johnson, seconded by Foote, that the licenses be granted subject to the approval of the City Sanitarian. Roll call as follows: Ayes, 4; No, None; carried.

The following Master Plumber license applications were presented, as follows, to-wit: Scott Bair, Bair's Plumbing; W. C. Sanderson, American Plumbing & Heating; Vern Saxton, Saxton's Plumbing. It was moved by Johnson, seconded by Petersen, that the licenses be granted, subject to the approval of the Plumbing Inspector. Roll call as follows: Ayes, 4; No, None; carried.

The following Electrical Contractors license applications and Journeymen Electricians license applications were presented to-wit: Irving M. Beazer, Lorenzo, Idaho; W. D. Bauchman, I. F. Electric Co.; Alva Lewis, Blackfoot, Idaho. Journeymen Electricians, Alva Lewis, Blackfoot, Idaho; Robert Oyler, I.F.; LaVar Bosworth, Eastern Idaho Construction. It was moved by Johnson, seconded by Freeman, that the licenses be granted, subject to the approval of the Electrical Inspector. Roll call as follows: Ayes, 4; No, None; carried.

The following Second Hand Store license application was presented. William M. Cox by Mrs. E. Stone, 285 N. Capital Avenue. It was moved by Councilman Johnson, seconded by Petersen, that the license be granted. Roll call as follows: Ayes, 4; No, None; carried.

The following liquor license application was presented. Capital Bar, Ray Metcalf. It was moved by Johnson, seconded by Foote, that the license be granted. Roll call as follows: Ayes, 4; No, None; carried.

The Mayor directed all Department Heads to obtain a copy of the new code books and study the section or sections pertaining to his or her Department, tabulating any changes, corrections or suggestions, which is felt necessary.

The bill from Sterling Codifiers was again presented. It was explained by the Mayor that there is no need to withhold payment until the code book is approved inasmuch as their contract so reads that they are obliged to make any necessary corrections and additions at any or all times into the future. It was moved by Freeman, seconded by Foote, that the bills be allowed and paid. Roll call as follows: Ayes, 4; No, None; carried.

The Mayor indicated that there is an immediate need for a desk and chair for the Building Inspector and recommended that a recently acquired bid of \$205.00 for same be accepted. It was moved by Johnson, seconded by Petersen, that the Mayor be authorized to accept the bid. Roll call as follows: Ayes, 4; No, None; carried.

Then there was a discussion on the pump bids for Capitol Hill. It was explained by the City Engineer that Nickerson not only had the low bid but that that firm had already a substantial investment in work done at that site. It was moved by Councilman Freeman, seconded by Johnson, that the Nickerson bid be accepted. Roll call as follows: Ayes, 4; No, None; carried.

The subject of the Stewart Sheep Company problem was again presented. It was moved by Petersen, seconded by Johnson, that they be instructed to build a site proof fence around the back and sides of their operation, and that they must move all their equipment and stored material back on to their own property. Roll call as follows: Ayes, Councilmen Petersen, Freeman, and Johnson; Nay, Councilman Foote; carried.

It was moved by Johnson, seconded by Petersen, that the Meeting adjourn. Roll call as follows: Ayes, 4; No, None. The Meeting adjourned.
