

NOVEMBER 27, 1957

Pursuant to a call by the Mayor, the City Council of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho met in Special Session in the Mayor's Chambers on Wednesday, at 11:00 A.M., November 27, 1957, for the purpose of considering a hook on charge for new users of the new sewer system, in the event the sewer bond election passes. Present: Mayor John B. Rogers; Councilmen Foote, Freeman, Johnson, Petersen. Absent: none. Also present: Roy C. Barnes, City Clerk; Arthur Smith, City Attorney; Claud Black, City Engineer.

It was moved by Councilman Freeman, seconded by Foote, that any new construction after 1-1-58 be charged approximately \$250.00 hook on charge to connect onto the sewer with possible special consideration for problem areas, said action to be subject to the sewer bond election passing. Roll call as follows: Ayes, Foote, Freeman, Johnson, Petersen. Nay, None; carried.

The Mayor mentioned the fact that \$16,000.00 was being transferred from the L.I.D. #19 fund to the general fund.

The Mayor also announced that the City has a chance to acquire a new clutch drive assembly unit for the Pak Mor garbage truck for \$499.00 and it was agreed that it should be ordered.

It was moved by Councilman Johnson, seconded by Petersen, that the Council adjourn. Carried.
