

AUGUST 8, 1957

Pursuant to a call by the Mayor, the City Council of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho met in a Special Session on Thursday, August 8, 1957, at the hour of 2:30 P.M. for the purpose of considering the rezoning of the L. R. Bird Trailer Court property. Present: John B. Rogers, Mayor; Councilmen Foote, Freeman, Johnson and Petersen. Also present: Roy C. Barnes, City Clerk; Arthur Smith, City Attorney.

Mr. Smith explained the problems involved in the zoning of the Bird property and Councilman Johnson stated that, in his opinion, any action taken other than that which was passed at the meeting of August 7th would be one of appeasement, rather than foresight.

It was moved by Councilman Johnson, seconded by Foote, that the Bird property be rezoned from R-1 to HC limited business with the understanding that a contract be prepared and signed by the owners whereby they would agree to carry out the requirements as presented at the meeting of August 7th, 1957. Roll call as follows: Ayes, Councilmen Foote, Johnson, Freeman; Nay, Councilman Petersen. Passed.

There being no further business, it was moved by Councilman Johnson, seconded by Petersen, that the Council adjourn. Carried.
