

APRIL 11, 1957

Pursuant to a call by the Mayor, the City Council of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, met in a special session on Thursday, April 11, 1957, at 2:00 o'clock P.M. in the City Hall, Idaho Falls, Idaho for the purpose of considering Falls Valley Sub-division and the purchase of Power Grader. Present: John B. Rogers, Mayor; Councilmen Johnson, Petersen, Freeman, and Foote. Also present: S. R. Rostad, City Clerk; Arthur Smith, City Attorney.

The following proposal received from the Western Equipment Company, Idaho Falls, to-wit:

Caterpillar No. 12 Motor Grader 3F6863, \$15,870.00; Freight, 969.98; Cab, 495.00; Heater, 103.00; Steering Booster, 623.00; Wheels & Tires, 136.00; Lighting system, 68.00; Foot Well, 51.00; Rain Traps, 8.50. **Total:** \$18,347.98 less, trade-in, 3,000.00;
Net: 15,347.98.

Referred to the Street Committee for attention.

David Benton, C. R. Stark and Dale Parish, appeared before the Council relative to the approval of plat covering Falls Valley Sub-division; after considerable discussion it was moved by Councilman Freeman, seconded by Petersen, that the preliminary plat of Falls Valley Sub-division, Division No. 1, be accepted, (87 lots). It was moved by Councilman Johnson, seconded by Petersen, that the plat of Gustafson Park Addition, Division No. 1 be accepted, that the property line shall be platted 40 feet from the Section line along the Sunnyside Road. Roll call as follows: Ayes, Councilmen Freeman, Foote, Johnson, and Petersen; No, None; carried.

It was moved by Councilman Johnson, seconded by Petersen, that the Council adjourn. Carried.
