The City Council of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, met in Recessed Session, Thursday, March 7, 1957, at 8 P.M. in the Council Chambers at Idaho Falls, Idaho. Present: John B. Rogers, Mayor; Councilmen Petersen, Foote, Johnson. Absent, Councilman Freeman. Also present: S. R. Rostad, City Clerk; T. R. Peters, P.A.; A. L. Smith, City Attorney; C. R. Black, City Engineer.

The minutes of Meetings held on February 15<sup>th</sup>, 19<sup>th</sup>, and March 1<sup>st</sup>, were read and approved.

Mr. Bush appeared before the Council, relative to traffic and mud conditions on Anderson Avenue near Whittier School. He wants some action taken relative to paving and mud conditions. Mayor Rogers advised that the Mayor and City Engineer would meet with the County Commissioners next Monday, to discuss the possibility of paving Anderson Avenue.

**RESOLUTION (Resolution No. 1957-03)**

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL  
OF THE CITY OF IDAHO FALLS, IDAHO:

**SECTION 1.** That a General Municipal election is hereby called pursuant to law to be held in the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, on Tuesday, the 2<sup>nd</sup> day of April, 1957, for the purpose of electing a Mayor for the term of two years and two Councilmen for terms of four years each.

**SECTION 2.** That the polls at said election shall be open at the hour of 9 o'clock A.M. and remain open continuously until the hour of 7 o'clock P.M. and then closed. Said Election shall be held at the voting places set forth in Section 4 hereof.

**SECTION 3.** That all persons who at the time of election are qualified electors of the City, properly registered and possessing the qualifications of residents shall be qualified to vote at said election and the ballots to be used at said election shall be in the form set forth in Section 50-3715, Section 50-3716, and Section 50-3717 Idaho Code.

**SECTION 4.** That notice of said election shall be given by the City Clerk by publication of the following notice in at least two issues in the Post Register a daily, except Saturday, newspaper printed and published in the City of Idaho Falls. The first of which publication shall be made not less than twenty (20) days previous to the date of said election; and the City Clerk shall give further notice of said election by posting said notice at each voting place to be used at said election and at two other public places in each precinct in said City for not less than twenty (20) days previous to said election. Said notice shall be in the form and shall contain the information as follows: to-wit:

**NOTICE OF GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION**

Pursuant to the laws of the State of Idaho notice is hereby given that a General Municipal Election shall be held in the City of Idaho Falls, Bonneville County, Idaho, at the voting places hereinafter designated on Tuesday, the 2<sup>nd</sup> day of April, 1957, beginning at the hour of 9:00 o'clock A.M. and closing at the hour of 7:00 o'clock P.M. of said day, for the purpose of electing a Mayor of the term of two years and two Councilmen for terms of four years each.

Notice is further given that only qualified electors of said City and who are registered as provided by law are entitled to vote at said election. No qualified elector who is duly registered as a voter in the last preceding General Municipal Election shall be required to register so long as he remains, or has remained, continuously after such registration, a duly qualified elector of the City of Idaho Falls; provided, after any qualified elector has reregistered, he has failed to keep his continuous residence and full qualifications to vote in said City, regardless of how short the term of his disqualification shall exist or have existed, shall not be entitled to vote at such election after such disqualification existed, unless he shall have reregistered for the election at which he next desires to vote. If such elector shall have removed to another precinct within the City, he or she shall notify the City Clerk of such change of address and such Clerk shall register him or her in the precinct to which the elector shall have removed.

S. R. Rostad, City Clerk, is the Ex-Officio Registrar of said City. The places of registration are the office of said City Clerk, in the City Building and the respective residences aforesaid of said deputy registrars.

Persons may register on each day of any time during the office hours of said City Clerk, beginning with the day the Notice of Election is given and continuing until and including Saturday next preceding the election; and on Thursday, Friday and Saturday next preceding the election, persons may register between the hours of 9:00 o'clock A.M. and 5:00 o'clock P.M. and between the hours of 7:00 o'clock P.M. and 9:00 o'clock P.M.
