ORDINANCE NO. 879

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 2 OF ORDINANCE NO. 617 OF THE ORDINANCES OF IDAHO FALLS TO PROVIDE THAT HEREAFTER THERE MAY BE ISSUED AND RENEWED UNDER THE DIRECTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL, AT LEAST TWENTY TAXICAB LICENSES; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES AND PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH; PROVIDING WHEN THE ORDINANCE SHALL BECOME EFFECTIVE.
