The City Council of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, met in Regular Session, February 15, 1957, at 8 P.M. in the Council chambers at Idaho Falls, Idaho. Present: John B. Rogers, Mayor; Councilmen Johnson, Petersen, Freeman, Foote. Also present: S. R. Rostad, City Clerk; R. R. Peters, P.A.; A. L. Smith, City Attorney; C. R. Black, City Engineer.

The minutes of Meetings held on February 7th and 13th, were read and approved.

It was moved by Councilman Johnson, seconded by Petersen, that the Purchasing Agent is hereby authorized to purchase from the Starline Equipment Co., Boise, Idaho, the following:

400 gallons yellow traffic paint @ \$2.95 per gallon.
12 gallons red traffic paint @ \$3.20 per gallon.

ORDINANCE NO. 878

AN ORDINANCE TO REGULATE THE INSPECTION, GRADING RE-GRADING, AND PLACARDING OF EATING AND DRINKING ESTABLISHMENTS, THE ISSUING, SUSPENSION, AND REVOCATION OF PERMITS FOR THE OPERATION OF SUCH ESTABLISHMENTS, THE ENFORCEMENT OF THIS ORDINANCE, AND THE FIXING OF PENALTIES; AND PROHIBITIVE THE SALE OF ADULTERATED, MISBRANDED OR UNWHOLESOME FOOD AND DRINK.

The foregoing Ordinance was presented in title. It was moved by Councilman Foote, seconded by Johnson, that the provisions of Section 50-2004 of the Idaho Code requiring all ordinances to be fully and distinctly read on three several days be dispensed with. The question being, "SHALL THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION 50-2004 OF THE IDAHO CODE REQUIRING ALL ORDINANCES TO BE READ ON THREE SEVERAL DAYS BE DISPENSED WITH?" Roll call as follows: Ayes, 4; No,

ORDINANCE NO. 879

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 2 OF ORDINANCE NO. 617 OF THE ORDINANCES OF IDAHO FALLS TO PROVIDE THAT HEREAFTER THERE MAY BE ISSUED AND RENEWED, UNDER THE DIRECTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL, AT LEAST TWENTY TAXICAB LICENSES; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES AND PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH; PROVIDING WHEN THE ORDINANCE SHALL BECOME EFFECTIVE.

The above Ordinance was read by the Clerk.

It was moved by Councilman Freeman and seconded by Johnson, that the above Ordinance be passed on its first and second reading. Roll call resulted as follows: Ayes: Councilmen Freeman, Foote, and Johnson; Nay: None; Councilmen Petersen abstained from voting.

The above petition was referred to the City Engineer.

Mr. David Benton, presented for consideration final plat of Pine Acres Subdivision to the City of Idaho Falls. It was moved by Councilman Johnson, seconded by Petersen, that the final plat of Pine Acres Subdivision be accepted and approved, that R-2 zoning be recommended for Lots 17 to 30 inclusive of Block 5, and Lot 3 of Block 6; R-1 zoning is recommended for all other lots in the addition. It was moved by Councilman Johnson and seconded by Foote, that up to 150 dwellings be permitted east of canal, in Ralph Williams, Jr., Subdivision; before access road onto First Street is required. Roll call resulted as follows: Ayes, Councilmen Petersen, Freeman, Foote, and Johnson; Nay, None; Motion Carried.

It was moved by Councilman Foote and seconded by Petersen, that the plat of Taylor Division, Division No. 1, be accepted. Roll call resulted as follows: Ayes, Councilmen Johnson, Petersen, Freeman, and Foote; No, None; Motion Carried.

It was moved by Councilman Johnson and seconded by Freeman, that the Mayor is hereby authorized to sign renewal Farm Lease to John A. Newman. Roll call resulted as follows: Ayes, 4; No, None; carried.

It was the sense of the Council that the Traffic Ordinances (Code) will be brought up-to-date.

Scott Williams appeared before the Council relative to solar electrical heating; referred to Light Committee, Donald R. Foote and George C. Petersen, Jr., and Ray Moore, Hy Hansen, and C. O. Crane.

It was moved by Councilman Johnson and seconded by Petersen, that the Council adjourn. Carried.
