

FEBRUARY 13, 1957

Pursuant to a call by the Mayor, the City Council of the City of Idaho Falls, met in a Special Session on Wednesday, February 13, 1957, at 3:00 P.M. for the purpose of considering changing Taxi Cab Ordinance. Present: John B. Rogers, Mayor; Councilmen Freeman, Foote, and Johnson; Absent, Councilman Petersen. Also present: S. R. Rostad, City Clerk; and A. L. Smith, City Attorney.

Petitions, signed by several citizens favoring change in Taxi Ordinance, were presented.

It was agreed that financial statements were immaterial at this time.

Mr. Naylor, Frank Newell (employee of the Greyhound Bus Co.), Norris Hendricksen, all spoke in favor of amending Ordinance to permit more taxicabs. Mr. Ferebauer, Paul Taylor, and Bruce Stoddard (Western Fleetline Cab Co.) spoke at length regarding operations, did not favor change in Taxi-Cab Ordinance.

It was moved by Councilman Freeman, seconded by Johnson, that the present Taxi Ordinance be amended to provide for 20 taxicabs. Roll call resulted as follows: Ayes, Councilmen Freeman, Johnson, and Foote; No, None; Absent, Councilman Petersen. Motion carried.

It was moved by Councilman Johnson and seconded by Foote, that the Council adjourn. Carried.
