

DECEMBER 21, 1956

The City Council of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, met in Regular Session, December 21, 1956, at 8 P.M. in the Council Chambers at Idaho Falls, Idaho. Present: John B. Rogers, Mayor; Councilmen Foote, Johnson, Petersen, and Freeman. Also present: S. R. Rostad, City Clerk; T. R. Peters, P.A.; A. L. Smith, City Attorney; and C. R. Black, City Engineer.

The minutes of Meetings held on December 7th and 12th were read and approved.

ORDINANCE NO. 872

AN ORDINANCE VACATING AND CLOSING A PORTION OF A CERTAIN EASEMENT IN LOT ONE (1) BLOCK TWO (2), MAPLEWOOD ADDITION TO THE CITY OF IDAHO FALLS, PER THE RECORDED PLAT THEREOF, FOR THE SOLE AND EXCLUSIVE USE OF HOMER-KOESTER COMPANY, AN IDAHO CORPORATION; PARTICULARLY DESCRIBEING SAID EASEMENT; PROVIDING WHEN THE ORDINANCE SHALL BECOME EFFECTIVE.

The foregoing Ordinance was presented in title. It was moved by Councilman Johnson, seconded by Petersen, that the provisions of Section 50-2004 of the Idaho Code requiring all ordinances to be fully and distinctly read on three several days be dispensed with. The question being, "SHALL THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION 50-2004 OF THE IDAHO CODE REQUIRING ALL ORDINANCES TO BE READ ON THREE SEVERAL DAYS BE DISPENSED WITH?" Roll call as follows: Ayes, 4; No, None; carried. The majority of all the members of the Council present having voted in the affirmative, the Mayor declared the rule dispensed with and ordered the Ordinance placed before the Council for final consideration the question being, "SHALL THE ORDINANCE PASS?" Roll call as follows: Ayes, 4; No, None; carried. The Mayor declared the Ordinance passed.

It was moved by Councilman Foote, seconded by Petersen, that the purchasing agent is hereby authorized to pay David E. Benton the amount of \$300.00 for preparing City planning map, 75 hours @ \$4.00 . Roll call as follows: Ayes, Councilmen Petersen, Freeman, Foote and Johnson; No, None; carried.

It was moved by Councilman Foote, seconded by Freeman, authorizing the payment to Mrs. Helen Lindquist for one month extra salary and vacation \$280.00. The Mayor is hereby instructed to

write a letter of appreciation for 25 ½ years of service. Roll call as follows: Ayes, 4; No, None; carried.

Attorney Kent Naylor appeared before the Council in behalf of John Schmier, Fred Schmier and Norris Hendrickson, regarding amending Ordinance governing Taxicabs.

It was moved by Councilman Petersen and seconded by Johnson, that a hearing date be set up, inviting both the present Taxi Company and the new proposed Taxi Company and to introduce evidence on past performance and future plans. Roll call as follows: Ayes, 4; No, None; carried.

RESOLUTION (Resolution No. 1956-23)

WHEREAS, JACK'S CHICKEN INN, INC., an Idaho Corporation, has petitioned the City Council requesting that certain lands owned by the City of Idaho Falls be sold at public auction, said lands lying and being in the City of Idaho Falls, Bonneville County, Idaho, and particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a point which is S. 29° 15' W. 1357 feet, and N. 60° 45' W. 177 feet, from the point of intersection of the Westerly Boundary Line of the Yellowstone Highway with the North Section Line of Section 25, Twp. 2 N. Range 37 E.B.M. and running thence N. 29° 15' E., 200 feet to the point of beginning, containing 1.86 acres, more or less and all located in Section 25, Twp. 2 N., Range 37 E.B.M. and

WHEREAS, said lands are not used, or needed, for public purposes; and the sale of the same is in the best interests of the inhabitants and taxpayers of said City;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF IDAHO FALLS, IDAHO;

1. That the above described lands shall be sold by the City Clerk for cash to the highest bidder at public auction on the steps at the front door of the City Hall in Idaho Falls, Idaho, on the 17th day of January, 1957, at 10:00 o'clock A.M. of said day; provided however, no bid shall be accepted for less than the appraised value of said lands, which value shall be determined as in the next paragraph set forth, and shall be on file in the office of the City Clerk prior to said sale.

2. That D. V. Groberg, V. R. Larsen, and Sterling Hansen, disinterested free holders of said City, be, and they are hereby appointed to appraise said lands and to file a statement setting forth the appraised value thereof in the office of the City Clerk prior to January 17, 1957.

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3. That the City Clerk shall give public notice of said sale by publishing a notice containing the time and place of said sale and a description of said lands for at least ten (10) days in the Post Register, the official newspaper of said City.

4. That said appraisal, notice, and sale shall be made and conducted in conformity with the provisions of Section 50-18 I. C. and the general law of the State of Idaho.
