

OCTOBER 19, 1956

The City Council of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, met in Regular Session, October 19, 1956, at 8 P. M. in the Council Chambers at Idaho Falls, Idaho. There were present at said meeting: Mayor John B. Rogers; Councilmen Johnson, Petersen, Freeman, Foote; Also present; T. R. Peters, Purchasing Agent; A. L. Smith, City Attorney; and Chaud Black, City Engineer.

The minutes of the Meeting held October 8, 1956, were read and approved.

Mr. Robert M. Krueger, 950 Poulson Street, North Bel Aire Addition, appeared before the Council requesting something be done about the sewage system in that block of Poulson Street.

Mr. Krueger, requested a written statement from the governing body assuring maintenance of the sewer put in by the individuals provided the sewer is installed according to all City specifications. Mayor Rogers informed Mr. Krueger, the minutes of this meeting would serve as the written statement as the minutes are public record.

Nate Bridges, V. F. W. spokesman, appeared in regard to Cliff Thiede, wrestling promoter, withdrawing the V. F. W. sponsorship for the wrestling matches. The V. F. W. wanted to know the reason for the termination of the sponsorship. Mayor Rogers requested a representative of the V. F. W. and Mr. Thiede meet in the Mayor's Office, at a later date, to settle the situation.

Mr. Lloyd Benton presented a plat of the new Lynn Haven Addition. It was moved by Johnson, seconded by Foote, that the plat be accepted. Roll call as follows: Aye: Petersen, Freeman, Foote, Johnson. Nay: None. The motion carried.

It was moved by Freeman, seconded by Foote, that the minutes of the Meeting of October 19, 1956 be used as the written agreement requested by Mr. Krueger. Roll call as follows: Aye; Johnson, Petersen, Freeman, Foote. Voting Nay; None. The motion carried.

The affidavit and show cause order for the revocation of the rooming house license of Sandra Hahn was presented. No action was taken and the affidavit and show cause order were tabled because of the absence of Sandra Hahn.

Five Tax Deeds, deeding property purchased by the City for taxes back to the original owners, Boyd Emery, Anzie Fletcher, C. L. Sharp, c/o Marie Cavey, Lorena M. Talbot, and Arnell D. Madsen, were presented. It was moved by Foote, seconded by Johnson, that the Mayor be authorized to sign these deeds. Roll call as follows: Aye; Petersen, Freeman, Foote, Johnson, Nay; None. Carried.

A Taxi Cab Drivers License for Denzel L. Rowberry was presented. It was moved by Johnson, seconded by Petersen, that the license be approved. Roll call as follows: Aye; Freeman, Foote, Johnson, Petersen. Nay; None. Carried.

A petition for a strip sign at 8th and Wabash was read by the Mayor. Chief of Police, Forrest G. Perrin, has already been informed on this matter and is attending to having the stop sign put up at this intersection.

The Planning Commission's report with reference to Subdivision Regulations was presented by Mayor Rogers. It was requested that there be further discussion on this subject before any action is taken by the City.

A request for new lights and light fixtures for the City Clerk's office was presented. The request was for slim line fixtures with an appraisal by I. F. Electric for \$720.00. It was moved by Freeman, seconded by Johnson, that the request be approved. Roll call as follows: Aye; Foote, Johnson, Petersen, Freeman. Nay; None. Carried.

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It was moved by Johnson, seconded by Petersen, that the Meeting adjourn. Roll call as follows: Aye; Petersen, Freeman, Foote, Johnson. Nay; None. carried. The Meeting adjourned.
