

OCTOBER 8, 1956

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The City Council of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, met in Regular Session, October 8, 1956, at 8 P.M. in the Council Chambers at Idaho Falls, Idaho. There were present at said Meeting: Mayor John B. Rogers; Councilmen Freeman, Foote, Johnson, and Petersen. Also present: Louise Anderson, Acting City Clerk; T. R. Peters, Purchasing Agent; A. L. Smith, City Attorney; and C. R. Black, City Engineer. The minutes of the Meeting held on September 21, were read and approved.

Mr. W. H. Walker, 767 Skyline Drive, appeared before the Council to see if the City could take steps to do something about the condition of Skyline Drive, which is paved only on one side causing hazardous traffic conditions. The matter was referred to the City Engineer who stated steps would be taken to correct the conditions immediately and that the Street will be placed in a special improvement district next year.

Mr. Phil Reichardt, 2425 Harrison Drive, appeared before the Council with regard to the proposed restrooms at the Lilac Circle at Tautphaus Park. The Council assured him the restrooms would have adequate supervision regarding sanitation and hazard.

Mr. Arden Hughes requested that the City assume responsibility for the supervision of the sewer operation and sludge pump in the Hughes Imperial Addition. This matter was referred to the Sanitation Committee of the Council.

The following application for electrical contractors license for Joe T. Baldree Jr., was read. The application was referred to the Electrical Inspector.

The bills against the City for the month of September, 1956, having been audited by the Finance Committee, were presented for payment as follows; to-wit;

The reports of the various departments for the month of September, 1956, were presented. There being no objection, they were ordered placed on file.

An application for Widow's Exemption on lights and water was presented. This was referred to Councilman Petersen for investigation.

The insurance policy for the lease agreement with the Snake River Boat Club, Inc. was presented. This was referred to the minutes of the Meeting on September 7, 1956.

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The yearly lease of O.D. Hendrickson, on the property at the north end of the Golf Course, was presented to the Council. It was moved by Freeman, seconded by Foote, that the lease be granted. Roll call as follows: Ayes, Johnson, Petersen, Freeman, Foote; Nay, None; Carried.

The off-street parking agreement and resolution was presented to the Council. The resolution reads as follows:

**RESOLUTION (Resolution No. 1956-20)**

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF IDAHO FALLS, IDAHO, AUTHORIZING SAID CITY TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH IDAHO FALLS OFF-STREET PARKING, INC. FOR THE LEASING AND SERVICING OF OFF-STREET PARKING LOTS.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF IDAHO FALLS, IDAHO:

That the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho do now make and enter into a lease and servicing agreement with Idaho Falls Off-Street Parking, Inc., an Idaho Corporation, whereby the City shall lease from the said Corporation certain off-street parking lots and the Corporation will be employed by the City as a maintenance and service corporation for said parking lots, the City to pay the annual rental of One Dollar (\$1.00) per year for each lot rented.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Mayor and City Clerk be, and they hereby are, authorized to enter into said lease and service agreement on behalf of said City.

**ORDINANCE NO. 869**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF IDAHO FALLS, IDAHO, PROVIDING FOR AUTHORIZATION TO ACQUIRE OFF-STREET PARKING LOTS, SETTING FORTH THE PUBLIC PURPOSES AND NECESSITY OF PARKING LOTS, PROVIDING PUBLIC RIGHT-OF-WAY AND STREETS, JURISDICTION AND CONTROL OF OFF-STREET PARKING LOTS.

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ORDINANCE NO. 870

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF IDAHO FALLS, IDAHO,  
CREATING, OPENING AND ESTABLISHING CERTAIN LOTS AS A  
MUNICIPAL PARKING LOT IN SAID CITY.

The above Ordinances were read by the Acting City Clerk.

It was moved by Foote, seconded by Johnson, that the Ordinances be passed on the first reading. Roll call as follows: Voting Aye, Freeman, Foote, Johnson, Petersen. Voting Nay, None. Carried.
