

CITY COUNCIL MEETING
AUGUST 31, 1956

Pursuant to a call by the Mayor, the City Council of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, met in a Special Session on Friday, August 31, 1956, at 2:20 P.M. in the City Hall, Idaho Falls, Idaho, for the purpose of annexing certain lands, as per Ordinance Nos. 863 and 864, and to authorize the Clerk to publish NOTICE OF ZONING HEARING to cover lands, as per Ordinance Nos. 853, 854, 860, 863, and 864, and to investigate the feasibility of filing declaratory judgment action against Thayne and Grant Earl. Present: John B. Rogers, Mayor; Councilmen Johnson, Petersen, Freeman and Foote. Also present: S. R. Rostad, City Clerk and A. L. Smith, City Attorney.

ORDINANCE NO. 863

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING CERTAIN LANDS TO THE CITY OF
IDAHO FALLS: DESCRIBING SAID LANDS AND DECLARING SAME
A PART OF THE CITY OF IDAHO FALLS, IDAHO

The above Ordinance was read by the City Clerk. It was moved by Councilman Foote and seconded by Johnson, that the above Ordinance be passed on its third and final reading. Roll call resulted as follows: Yes, Councilmen Petersen, Freeman, Foote and Johnson; No, None; Motion carried.

ORDINANCE NO. 864

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING CERTAIN LANDS TO THE CITY OF
IDAHO FALLS; DESCRIBING SAID LANDS AND DECLARING SAME
A PART OF THE CITY OF IDAHO FALLS, IDAHO.

The above Ordinance was read by the City Clerk. It was moved by Councilman Foote and seconded by Johnson, that the provisions of Section 50-2004 of Idaho Code, requiring all Ordinances to be fully and distinctly read on three several days be dispensed with. The question being, "SHALL THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION 50-2004 OF THE IDAHO CODE REQUIRING ALL ORDINANCES TO BE READ ON THREE SEVERAL DAYS BE DISPENSED WITH?" Roll call resulted as follows: Yes, Councilmen Freeman, Foote, Johnson, and Petersen; No, None. The majority of all members of the Council having voted in the affirmative, the Mayor declared the rule dispensed with and ordered the Ordinance placed before the Council for final consideration, the question being, "SHALL THE ORDINANCE PASS?" Roll call resulted as follows: Yes, Councilmen Freeman, Foote, Johnson and Petersen; No, None. The majority of all members of the Council having voted in the affirmative, the Mayor declared the Ordinance passed.

It was moved by Councilman Freeman and seconded by Johnson, that the City Clerk is hereby authorized to publish in the Post Register, NOTICE OF ZONING HEARING, to be held in the Council Chambers in the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, on Friday, the 21st day of September, 1956, at 8 o'clock P.M. of said day for the purpose of conducting public hearing in relation to the zoning of all of the following described lands within the said City, to-wit; lands as covered by Ordinance Nos. 852, 854, 860, 863, and 864. Roll call resulted as follows: Yes, Councilmen Johnson, Petersen, Freeman, and Foote; No, None; Motion carried.

It was the sense of the Council that permission be given to loan 4 sections of bleachers, from rodeo grounds, to the Idaho Falls football field, for the football season.
