

CITY COUNCIL MEETING
AUGUST 29, 1956

Pursuant to a call by the Acting Mayor, the City Council of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, met in a Special Session on Wednesday, August 29, 1956, at 8 P.M. in the Council Chambers at Idaho Falls, Idaho, for the purpose of opening bids for lighting installation at the Idaho Falls Municipal Airport, and to authorize the Clerk to advertise for bids for painting water tank, for painting buildings at Tautphaus Park, and large hangar and caretakers residence at Fanning Field, and authorize the Purchasing Agent to place orders for transformers. Present: Donald R. Foote, Acting Mayor; Councilmen Donald R. Foote, George C. Petersen, Jr., and Vernon S. Johnson; Absent, Councilman R. A. Freeman. Also present: S. R. Rostad, City Clerk; T. R. Peters, Purchasing Agent; Al Smith, City Attorney; C. R. Black, City Engineer.

The Mayor announced that this was the date set for opening of bids, for lighting installation at the Idaho Falls Municipal Airport, as per invitation for bids as advertised August 10th, 17th, and 24th; the bids were opened and read as follows:

BABBITT ELECTRIC & REFRIGERATION:	Idaho Falls, Idaho,	19,699.99
BANNOCK ELECTRIC CO.:	Pocatello, Idaho	20,765.02

It was moved by Councilman Johnson and seconded by Petersen, that the City of Idaho Falls recommend to the C. A. A. that the Airport lighting contract be awarded to the Babbitt Electric & Refrigeration Co., Idaho Falls, Idaho, in the amount of \$19,669.99. Roll call resulted as follows: Yes, Councilmen Petersen, Foote and Johnson; No, None; Motion carried.

It was moved by Councilman Petersen and seconded by Johnson, that the City Clerk is hereby authorized to advertise for bids as follows:

Labor and material and performing all work for painting of the 500,000 gallon water tank and supporting structure.

For the furnishing all labor, equipment, tools and performing all work for painting the exterior of the following buildings at Tautphaus Park, Idaho Falls, Idaho: "The Hut Restroom", "Caretakers Residence", "Garage and Tool House", and "Monkey House".

For furnishing all labor, equipment, tools and performing all work for painting the exterior of the "Administration Building", "Large Hangar", and "Caretakers Residence" at Fanning Field, Idaho Falls, Idaho.

Roll call resulted as follows: Yes, 3; No, None; Motion carried. It was moved by Councilman Johnson and seconded by Petersen, that the Purchasing Agent is hereby authorized to place orders for the following transformers:

3-167 KVA Transformers; 8-25 KVA Transformers and 8-15 KVA Transformers.

Roll call resulted as follows: Yes, 3; No, None; Motion carried. It was moved by Councilman Johnson and seconded by Petersen, that the Council adjourn; Carried.
