

CITY COUNCIL MEETING  
AUGUST 13, 1956

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Pursuant to a call by the Mayor, the City Council of the City of Idaho Falls, met in a Special Session on Monday, August 13, 1956, at 2 P.M. in the City Hall, Idaho Falls, Idaho, for the purpose of considering Airport lighting bids, and to re-advertise for bids, for lighting installation, at the Idaho Falls Municipal Airport. Present: John B. Rogers, Mayor; Councilmen Foote, Freeman and Johnson; Absent, Councilman Petersen. Also present: S. R. Rostad, City Clerk and C. R. Black, City Engineer. It was moved by Councilman Foote and seconded by Petersen, that all bids for lighting installation at the Idaho Falls Municipal Airport, are hereby **rejected**, and the City Clerk is hereby authorized to advertise for new bids, for lighting installation at the Airport, as per invitation for bids. Bids to be opened at 8 P.M. August 29, 1956.
