

CITY COUNCIL MEETING  
AUGUST 7, 1956

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The City Council of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, met in Recessed Session, August 7, 1956, at 8 P.M. in the Council Chambers at Idaho Falls, Idaho. Present: John B. Rogers, Mayor; Councilmen Petersen, Freeman and Foote; Absent, Councilman Johnson. Also present: S. R. Rostad, City Clerk; T. R. Peters, Purchasing Agent; C. R. Black, City Engineer.

The minutes of Meetings held on July 20 and August 3, were read and approved.

The bills against the City for the month of July 1956, having been audited by the Finance Committee, were presented for payment as follows, to-wit;
