

CITY COUNCIL MEETING

JULY 6, 1956

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The City Council of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, met in Regular Session, July 6<sup>th</sup>, 1956, at 8 P.M. in the Council Chambers at Idaho Falls, Idaho. There were present: John B. Rogers, Mayor; Councilmen Freeman, Foote and Johnson; absent, Councilman Petersen. Also present: S. R. Rostad, City Clerk; T. R. Peters, Purchasing Agent; A. L. Smith, City Attorney; C. R. Black, City Engineer.

The minutes of Meetings held on June 27<sup>th</sup>, and 29<sup>th</sup>, were read and approved.

The bills against the City for the month of June, 1956, having been audited by the Finance Committee, were presented for payment as follows, to-wit:

The reports of the various Departments for the month of June, were presented. There being no objection, they were ordered placed on file.

It was moved by Councilman Johnson and seconded by Freeman, that the applications by Ralph Quigley, and Dick W. O'Brien, for Taxi Operator Licenses, be granted, subject to the approval of the Chief of Police. Roll call resulted as follows: Yes, 3; No, None; Motion carried.

It was moved by Councilman Johnson and seconded by Foote, that the Municipal Audit Contract, for the Fiscal Year May 1, 1956 to April 30, 1957, be approved and accepted. The Mayor is hereby authorized to sign the contract. Roll call resulted as follows: Ayes, Councilmen Freeman, Foote, and Johnson; No, None; Motion carried.

It was moved by Councilman Freeman and seconded by Foote, that the claim of Albert G. Kephart, amount \$7.59 be denied. Roll call resulted as follows: Ayes, 3; No, None; Motion carried.

It was moved by Councilman Johnson and seconded by Freeman, that the account of D. W. Clark, 1396 S Blvd., \$54.20 and the account of Del Clark, 330 First Street, amount \$135.94, be charged off. Bankruptcy proceedings Oakland, CA. No assets. Roll call resulted as follows: Ayes, 3; No, None; Motion carried.

A letter dated June 28<sup>th</sup>, 1956, from the Chamber of Commerce, regarding one-way traffic on Shoup, Park, Capital, A & B Streets, was read. Mayor and Council to meet with the Chamber of Commerce, Traffic Committee, to discuss one-way traffic.

It was moved by Councilman Johnson and seconded by Foote, that the Council adjourn. Carried.

It was moved by Councilmen and seconded by Petersen, that the balance of \$206.50 due on cemetery lots, by Leland N. Petersen, be paid at the rate of \$10.00 per month, until paid in full. Roll call resulted as follows: Ayes, 4; No, None; Motion carried.
