

**CITY COUNCIL MEETING**

**JUNE 27, 1956**

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The City Council of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, met in Recessed Session, June 27, 1956, at 8 P.M. in the Council Chambers at Idaho Falls, Idaho. Present: John B. Rogers, Mayor; Councilmen Freeman, Foote, Johnson, and Petersen. Also present: S. R. Rostad, City Clerk; Arthur L. Smith, City Attorney; C. R. Black, City Engineer.

The minutes of a Meeting held on June 15, 1956, were read and approved.

The Mayor announced that this was the date set for the opening of bids, for Airport improvements, as per invitation for bids, as advertised on June 12<sup>th</sup>, 19<sup>th</sup>, and 26<sup>th</sup>. The bids were opened and read as follows:

The above bids referred to the City Engineer for checking and tabulation.

It was moved by Councilman Freeman and seconded by Johnson, that the contract for parking lot and alley paving located in Block 50 O.T. near swimming pool, be awarded to Carl E. Nelson Construction Company, at a price of \$8,362.35. Roll call resulted as follows: Ayes, Councilmen Petersen Freeman, Foote and Johnson; No, None, Motion carried.

**RESOLUTION (Resolution No. 1956-11)**

WHEREAS, the City of Idaho Falls, did, under and pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 29, Title 50, Idaho Code, and by deed of the City Treasurer dated the 10<sup>th</sup> day of November, 1952, recorded on Book 85 of Deeds at Page 287, records of Bonneville County, Idaho, acquire title to and possession of the following described real property, to-wit:

Lots 31 and 32 in Block 30 of Capitol Hill Addition to the City  
of Idaho Falls, Idaho.

WHEREAS, Rex Meikle has offered to pay to the City of Idaho Falls the amount for which said property was sold to the City, together with all the installments of assessments subsequent to the one for which said property was sold and then due, together with penalties and interest thereon;

Mr. Melvin Empey, appeared before the Council, relative to garbage removal proposal; \$1.10 per month for single family; \$3.00 per month for apartments and time basis for down-town area. No action taken.

It was moved by Councilman Freeman and seconded by Johnson, that the account of Peggy K. Hansen, Account No. F 616, \$21.55, be charged off. Widow, husband died September 1954. Roll call resulted as follows: Yes, 4; No, None; Motion carried.

It was moved by Councilman Johnson and seconded by Foote, that permission be granted for the J. C.'s and American Legion to display fireworks across the River, if they so desire. Roll call resulted as follows: Ayes, 4; No, None; Motion carried.

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It was moved by Councilman Petersen and seconded by Johnson, that the Council adjourn.
