

CITY COUNCIL MEETING

APRIL 16th, 1956

Pursuant to a call by the Mayor, the City Council of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, met in a Special Session on Monday, April 16th, 1956, at 2:30 P.M. at the City Hall, for the purpose of appointing a Councilman for the unexpired term of John B.
