

CITY COUNCIL MEETING

APRIL 6, 1956

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The City Council of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, met in Regular Session, April 6, 1956, at 8 P.M. in the Council Chambers at Idaho Falls, Idaho. Present: John B. Rogers, Mayor; Councilmen Petersen, Freeman and Foote. Also present: S. R. Rostad, City Clerk; T. R. Peters, Purchasing Agent; C. R. Black, City Engineer.

The minutes of a Meeting held on March 16, 1956, were read and approved.

Melvin Anderson & Ray Andrews, Pocatello, appeared before the Council relative to proposed Restlawn Memorial Park north of Beach's corner, explaining in detail the proposed memorial.

Mr. Benton presented to the Council a plat of Linden Park Addition, Division No. 6, for approval. It was moved by Councilman Freeman and seconded by Foote, that the above plat be accepted. Roll call resulted as follows: Yes, 3; No, None; Motion carried.

Mr. Benton presented a plat of Westland Heights Addition, Division No. 1, for approval. After considerable discussion, no action was taken.

C. R. Black presented to the Council a plat of Safstrom Addition, Division No. 5, for approval. It was moved by Councilman Petersen and seconded by Freeman, that the above plat be accepted. Roll call resulted as follows: Yes, 3; No, None; Motion carried.

It was moved by Councilman Foote and seconded by Freeman, that the appeal by Albertsons Food Center, 1<sup>st</sup> & Holmes, for illuminated signs, be denied. Roll call resulted as follows: Yes, 3; No, None; Motion carried.

It was moved by Councilman Petersen and seconded by Freeman, that the proposed pickup and delivery station building, to be erected at the corner of 2<sup>nd</sup> and Holmes, Lots 43 and 44, Block 1, Crows Addition, be approved as recommended by the Appeal Board. Council should be consulted in advance before proposing any advertising signs. Roll call resulted as follows: Yes, Councilmen Foote, Petersen and Freeman; No, None; Motion carried.

ORDINANCE NO. 858

AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING THE LICENSING OF ALL DOGS WITHIN THE CITY OF IDAHO FALLS; ESTABLISHING THE FEE FOR OBTAINING LICENSES AND DUPLICATE LICENSES; PROVIDING THAT THE LICENSE TAG SHALL BE DISPLAYED AT ALL TIMES UPON THE NECK OF EACH DOG LICENSED; PROVIDING FOR THE IMPOUNDING AND DISPOSAL OF UNLICENSED DOGS AND THE PROCEDURE FOR REDEEMING THEM; DECLARING CERTAIN DOGS TO BE PUBLIC NUISANCES AND PARTICULARLY DESCRIBING SUCH DOGS; PROVIDING FOR THE SEIZURE AND IMPOUNDING OF DOGS WHICH ARE NUISANCES AND PROVIDING THE PROCEDURE FOR REDEEMING THEM; REQUIRING DOGS WHICH DAMAGE PROPERTY TO BE CONFINED; PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION OF THE ORDINANCE; REPEALING ORDINANCES AND PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH; PROVIDING WHEN THE ORDINANCE BECOMES EFFECTIVE.

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The foregoing Ordinance was read by the City Clerk. It was moved by Councilman Petersen, seconded by Foote, that the provisions of Section 50-2004 of the Idaho Code requiring all Ordinances to be fully and distinctly read on three several days be dispensed with. The question being, "SHALL THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION 50-2004 OF THE IDAHO CODE REQUIRING ALL ORDINANCES TO BE READ ON THREE SEVERAL DAYS BE DISPENSED WITH?" Roll call as follows: Ayes, Councilmen Petersen, Freeman and Foote; No, None. The majority of all the members of the Council present having voted in the affirmative, the Mayor declared the rule dispensed with and ordered the Ordinance placed before the Council for final consideration the question being, "SHALL THE ORDINANCE PASS?" Roll call as follows: Ayes, Councilmen Petersen, Freeman and Foote; No, None. The majority of all the members of the Council having voted in the affirmative, the Mayor declared the Ordinance passed.

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING CERTAIN LANDS TO THE CITY OF IDAHO FALLS: DESCRIBING SAID LANDS AND DECLARING SAME A PART OF THE CITY OF IDAHO FALLS, IDAHO
