

CITY COUNCIL MEETING

APRIL 5, 1956

Pursuant to a call by the Mayor, the City Council of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, met in a Special Session on Thursday April 5th, 1956, at 3:30 P.M. at the City Hall, for the purpose of considering Palisades Power Contract, and the appointment of Mayor for the City of Idaho Falls, and considering Lease with the Idaho Falls Baseball Club, Inc. There were present: John B. Rogers, Mayor Pro Tem; Councilmen Petersen, Freeman, and Foote. Also present: S. R. Rostad, City Clerk; A. L. Smith, City Attorney.

It was moved by Councilman Freeman and seconded by Petersen, that John B. Rogers be appointed as Mayor, to serve out the term of the late E. W. Fanning, to the next election, April 1957. Pay as of March 29, 1956 @\$7,200.00 per annum. Roll call resulted as follows: Yes, Councilmen Foote, Petersen and Freeman; No, None; Motion carried.

It was moved by Councilman Freeman and seconded by Foote, that the Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized and directed to sign lease with the Idaho Falls Baseball Club Inc., for the baseball season of 1956, for the baseball field at Highland Park. Rental as follows: The sum of \$500.00 on the first 75,000 attendance, and \$100 for each additional 10,000 attendance or major fraction thereof. Roll call resulted as follows: Yes, Councilmen Petersen, Freeman and Foote; No, None; Motion carried. Mayor Rogers extended a hearty welcome to all visitors.

Mr. Harold Nelson, Regional Director, Palisades project of Boise, Idaho and others explained that the first generator was expected to be installed and power generated during December 1956. No action was taken on power contract.

It was moved by Councilman Petersen and seconded By Foote, that the Council adjourn. Carried.
