

CITY COUNCIL MEETING
MARCH 8, 1956

The City Council of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, met in Recessed Session, March 8, 1956, at 8 P.M. in the Council Chambers at Idaho Falls, Idaho. There were present: John B. Rogers, Mayor Pro Tempore; Councilmen Rogers, Foote and Petersen; Absent, Councilman Freeman. Also present: S. R. Rostad, Clerk; T. R. Peters, Purchasing Agent; Arthur L. Smith, City Attorney; C. R. Black, City Engineer.

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ORDINANCE NO. 856

AN ORDINANCE VACATING AND CLOSING THREE EASEMENTS IN THE CITY OF IDAHO FALLS, IDAHO, FOR THE SOLE AND EXCLUSIVE USE OF A. W. BRUNT AGENCY, INC. A CORPORATION, ITS SUCCESSORS AND ASSIGNS; PARTICULARLY DESCRIBING SAID LANDS; PROVIDING WHEN THE ORDINANCE SHALL BECOME EFFECTIVE.

The foregoing Ordinance was read by the City Clerk. It was moved by Councilman Foote, seconded by Petersen, that the provisions of Section 50-2004 of the Idaho Code requiring all Ordinances to be fully and distinctly read on three several days be dispensed with.
