

CITY COUNCIL MINUTES
JANUARY 20, 1956

The City Council of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, met in Regular Session, January 20, 1956, at 8 P.M. in the Council Chambers at Idaho Falls, Idaho. Present: E. W. Fanning, Mayor; Councilmen Foote, Rogers, Petersen. Also present: S. R. Rostad, City Clerk; Arthur L. Smith, City Attorney; C. R. Black, City Engineer.

The minutes of Meetings held on January 6th and 16th, were read and approved.

Mr. Potter Howard and Mr. Gibson, representing the Intermountain Gas Co., made a formal application to the Mayor and Council, for a gas franchise to distribute gas in the City of Idaho Falls. No action taken at this time.

Dear Mr. Black:

This letter is to formally request right-of-way for five poles and one down guy to be located along the south property line fence of City of Idaho Falls land located in Section 14 of T. 2N., R. 37 E.B.M. as shown on attached sketch.

This single phase tap line will allow removal of our present underground and pole line circuit located north of the proposed line. Removal of this line will allow unobstructed approach to the Northeast-Southwest runway at the Airport.

An easement form showing the description of the above mentioned poles and down guy, will be submitted for signing upon completion of a survey.

It was moved by Councilman Rogers and seconded by Foote, that the Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized and directed to sign 5 year lease, January 15, 1956 thru June 30, 1956, then from year to year to June 30, 1961, at a rental of \$75.00, per month, with the Corps of Engineers, Walla Walla, Washington, United States of America, for portion of Armory Building, B Street and Louis Drive. Roll call resulted as follows: Yes, Councilmen Rogers, Petersen, and Foote; No, None; Motion carried.

It was moved by Councilman Petersen and seconded by Rogers, that the Council adjourn, Carried.
