

AUGUST 19, 1955

The City Council of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, met in Regular Session, August 19, 1955, at 8 P.M. in the Council Chambers at Idaho Falls, Idaho. Present: E. W. Fanning, Mayor; Councilmen Foote, Rogers, Petersen, and Freeman. Also present: S. R. Rostad, City Clerk; T. R. Peters, Purchasing Agent; A. L. Smith, City Attorney; C. R. Black, City Engineer.

The minutes of Meetings held on August 5th and 9th, were read and approved.

Dr. N. M. Hansen, representing the Junior Chamber of Commerce, regarding use of swimming pool on September 3, 1955, for the children who have been taking lessons at the pool; this swimming meet to be conducted by the Red Cross.
