

MAY 20, 1955

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The City Council of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, met in Regular Session, May 20, 1955, at 8 P.M. in the Council Chambers at Idaho Falls, Idaho. Present: E. W. Fanning, Mayor; Councilmen Foote, Rogers, Petersen and Freeman. Also present: S. R. Rostad, City Clerk; T. R. Peters, Purchasing Agent; Arthur L. Smith, City Attorney; C. R. Black, City Engineer.

The minutes of a Meeting held on May 6<sup>th</sup>, 1955, were read and approved.

Reed Williams representing Cliff Kindred, Baldwin Super Market, relative to the rezoning of property at 8<sup>th</sup> and Holmes, to permit building extension to Store Building.
