

MAY 6, 1955

The City Council of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, met in Regular Session, May 6, 1955, at 8 P.M. in the Council Chambers at Idaho Falls, Idaho. Present: E. W. Fanning, Mayor; Councilmen Freeman, Foote and Rogers; Absent, Councilman Petersen. Also present: S. R. Rostad, City Clerk; T. R. Peters, Purchasing Agent; Arthur L. Smith, City Attorney; C. R. Black, City Engineer.

The minutes of Meetings held on April 15th and 29th were read and approved.

The bills against the City for the month of April 1955, having been audited by the Finance Committee, were presented for payment as follows, to-wit:

It was moved by Councilman Freeman and seconded by Foote, that the above bills be allowed and the Clerk is hereby authorized to draw warrants on the proper funds, in payment of the same. Roll call resulted as follows: Yes, 3; No, None; Motion carried.

The reports of the various Departments for the month of April, were presented. There being no objection, the reports were ordered placed on file.

It was moved by Councilman Freeman and seconded by Foote, that the bid by Aiman Construction Company, Idaho Falls, Idaho, in the amount of \$13,992.00, for the construction of concrete and steel bridge, across the Butte Arm of the Idaho Canal, at 21st Street and Cemetery Drive, be accepted; (pre-cast concrete beams). Roll call resulted as follows: Yes, Councilmen Freeman, Foote, and Rogers; No, None; Motion carried.

It was moved by Councilman Freeman and seconded by Rogers, that a limited Photographers license be granted to G. F. Martin, Gate City Portrait, 225 N. Main Street, Pocatello, restricted to the taking of pictures for and at Albertson's Stores. Roll call resulted as follows: Yes, 3; No, None; Motion carried.

The following applications for licenses were presented, to-wit;

It was moved by Councilman Freeman and seconded by Rogers, that the above licenses be granted. Roll call resulted as follows: Yes, 3; No, None; Motion carried.

Joe Armstrong appeared before the Council, regarding parking on Lee Avenue, south of First Street, west side of his store or the east side of Lee Avenue, limited to one hour parking. It was the sense of the Council that this arrangement be given a trial, leaving sufficient space for traffic to make turn off First Street.

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Mr. O. D. Hendricksen and D. A. Burkhalter, appeared before the Council, relative to leasing a strip of about 100 feet wide by 150 feet long, at the northeastern corner of the Golf Course, at the junction of the Yellowstone Highway and Lincoln Road, for a fruit and flower market.

The above request was referred to the Parks-Cemetery and Golf Course Committee. It was moved by Councilman Rogers and seconded by Foote.

Mayor Fanning made the following appointments: Finance, Aviation, Light & Water Committee, George C. Petersen, Jr., Chairman, Donald Foote. Streets and Alleys, Donald R. Foote, Chairman and John B. Rogers. Parks, Cemetery and Golf Course, R. A. Freeman, Chairman and George C. Petersen, Jr. Police, Sanitation, Building and Fire, John B. Rogers, Chairman and R. A. Freeman. Mayor Fanning re-appointed all present City Officials. It was moved by Councilman Freeman and seconded by Rogers, that the above appointments be approved. Roll call resulted as follows: Yes, Councilmen Freeman, Foote and Rogers; No, None; Motion carried.

Discussion was then heard relative to the acquisition of the land for the Airport. City Attorney A. L. Smith then reported that pursuant to the instruction of the Mayor, he had notified in writing that the City now offers Charles Reed, \$58,500.00, for his farm and offers Andrew Newman \$48,000.00 for his farm. The Attorney further reported that the offers must be accepted by May 15, 1955, or the City would condemn the land.

It was moved by Councilman Rogers and seconded by Foote, that the aforesaid action on the part of the City Attorney be ratified. Roll call resulted as follows: Yes, Councilmen Foote, Rogers, and Freeman; Nay, None; Motion carried.

It was moved by Councilman Freeman and seconded by Rogers, that the Council adjourn; Carried.
