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The City Council of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, met in a Regular Session February 18, 1955, at 8 P.M. in the Council Chambers at Idaho Falls, Idaho. Present: E. W. Fanning, Mayor; Councilmen Petersen, Freeman and Foote; Absent, Councilman Rogers. Also present: S. R. Rostad, City Clerk; T. R. Peters, Purchasing Agent; C. R. Black, City Engineer.

The minutes of Meeting held on February 8, 1955, were read and approved.

The following applications were presented, to-wit; BARTENDERS PERMITS: Robert R. Scott, Jack Edwards, James Scheets, E. H. Thornton and Eugene Petersen. BEER LICENSE TRANSFER: Garland Dennis to Ross L. Simmons, The Turf. It was moved by Councilman Freeman and seconded by Foote, that the above permits and transfer be granted. **RESOLUTION (Resolution No. 1955-05)**

WHEREAS, the City of Idaho Falls, did, under and pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 29, Title 50, Idaho Code, and by deed of the City Treasurer dated the 21<sup>st</sup> day of December, 1954, recorded in Book 94, of Deeds at Page 261, records of Bonneville County, Idaho, acquire title to and possession of the following described real property, to-wit:

Lot Twelve (12), Block Ninety-Seven (97) Riverside Addition to the Town of Eagle Rock, now the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho.

WHEREAS, Dean Bodily has offered to pay to the City of Idaho Falls the amount for which said property was sold to the City, together with all the installments of assessments subsequent to the one for which said property was sold and then due, together with penalties and interest thereon;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

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That the Mayor and City Clerk be, and they hereby are, authorized and directed, upon the payment of said sum of money by said purchaser, to make, execute and deliver to the said Dean Bodily a deed to said property, pursuant to the provisions of Section 50-2951, Idaho Code.
