Black, City Engineer.

ORDINANCE NO. 844

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE FIRE PREVENTION CODE EDITION OF 1953, RECOMMENDED BY THE NATIONAL BOARD OF FIRE UNDERWRITERS AND THE 1954 AMENDMENTS THERETO AS THE FIRE PREVENTION ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF IDAHO FALLS; REPEALING ORDINANCES AND PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT THEREWITH; PROVIDING THEN THE ORDINANCE SHALL BECOME EFFECTIVE.

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The foregoing Ordinance was read by the City Clerk. It was moved by Councilman Rogers, seconded by Petersen, that the provisions of Section 50-2004 of the Idaho Code requiring all Ordinances to be fully and distinctly read on three several days be dispensed with. The question being, "SHALL THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION 50-2004 OF THE IDAHO CODE REQUIRING ALL ORDINANCES TO BE READ ON THREE SEVERAL DAYS BE DISPENSED WITH?" Roll call as follows: Ayes, Foote, Rogers, Petersen and Freeman; No, None. The majority of all the members of the Council present having voted in the affirmative, the Mayor declared the rule dispensed with and ordered the Ordinance placed before the Council for final consideration the question being, "SHALL THE ORDINANCE PASS?" Roll call as follows: Ayes, Foote, Rogers, Petersen and Freeman; No, None. The majority of all the members of the Council having voted in the affirmative, the Mayor declared the Ordinance passed.

It was moved by Councilman Foote and seconded by Freeman, that the City Treasurer is hereby authorized to invest the following amounts in L.I.D. #24 Bonds, to-wit:

20,000.00 from Police Retirement Fund  
44,000.00 from L. I. D. Guaranty Fund

**RESOLUTION (Resolution No. 1955-03)**

WHEREAS, the City of Idaho Falls, did, under and pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 29, Title 50, Idaho Code, and by deed of City Treasurer dated the 10<sup>th</sup> day of November, 1952, recorded in Book 87 of deeds at Page 333, records of Bonneville County, Idaho, acquire title to and possession of the following described real property, to-wit:

The north half of Lot Thirty; and that tract of land commencing at the northeast corner of said Lot Thirty, thence east Fifty feet; thence in a straight diagonal line to the southeast corner of the north half of said Lot Thirty; thence due north 62½ feet to the point of beginning; all in Block (16) Sixteen, in South Park Addition to the original Town of Eagle Rock, now in the City of Idaho Falls, Bonneville County, Idaho, as per the recorded plat thereof.

WHEREAS, Vernon D. Redfield has offered to pay to the City of Idaho Falls the amount for which said property was sold to the City, together with all the installments of assessments subsequent to the one for which said property was sold and then due, together with penalties and interest thereon;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED;

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That the Mayor and City Clerk be, and they hereby are, authorized and directed, upon the payment of said sum of money by said purchaser, to make, execute and deliver to the said Vernon D. Redfield and Lulu E. Redfield, a deed to said property, pursuant to the provisions of Section 50-2951, Idaho Code.
