

SEPTEMBER 8, 1954

The City Council of the City of Idaho Falls met in Regular Session September 8th, 1954. There were present at said Meeting: Mayor E. W. Fanning, Mayor; Councilmen Petersen, Freeman, Foote and Rogers. Absent: None. T. R. Peters, Purchasing Agent; S. R. Rostad, City Clerk; Claude Black, City Engineer, were also present.

The minutes of Meetings held on August 25th and 31st, were approved.

Marshall Keyes, President of the Chamber of Commerce, presented Police Chief, Forrest Perrin, the Gold Seal of Progress Award given by the Chamber of Commerce of Mission, Texas, for outstanding achievement as a law enforcement officer. Perrin was named Idaho Police Chief of the year. It was moved by Foote, seconded by Rogers, that the award become a permanent record of the City of Idaho Falls. Roll call voting Yes, Rogers, Petersen, Freeman and Foote; No, None; Motion carried.

D. H. Loosli appeared before the Council and requested the City to install about 830 feet of water pipe to serve a new storage warehouse which an undisclosed company plans to erect near the Airport Road. The Mayor advised him that under the present City Ordinances the builders of any new development must install their own water mains. After some discussion the matter was referred to the Water and Light Committee and the City Attorney.

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It was moved by Foote, seconded by Petersen, that the City purchase one and one-half acres of land from the Utah Power & Light Company for One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00). This property is situated near the lower power plant. Roll call voting Ayes, Petersen, Freeman, Foote, Rogers; Nay, None; Motion carried.

It was moved by Rogers, seconded by Petersen, that the Meeting adjourn. Roll call voting Aye, Petersen, Freeman, Foote, Rogers; Nay, None; Motion carried.
