

AUGUST 25, 1954

The City Council of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, met in Recessed Session, August 25, 1954, at 8 P.M. in the Council Chambers at Idaho Falls, Idaho. Present: E. W. Fanning, Mayor; Councilmen Freeman, Foote, Rogers, and Petersen. Also present: S. R. Rostad, City Clerk; T. R. Petersen, Purchasing Agent; Arthur L. Smith, City Attorney; C. R. Black, City Engineer.

The minutes of Meetings held on August 6th, 10th, 19th, were approved.
