

AUGUST 10, 1954

The City Council of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, met in Recessed Session August 10, 1954, at 8:00 p.m. in the Council Chambers at Idaho Falls, Idaho. Present: E. W. Fanning, Mayor; Councilmen Petersen, Freeman, Foote, and Rogers; Also Present, S. R. Rostad, City Clerk, Arthur L. Smith, City Attorney, and C. R. Black, City Engineer.

The Mayor announced that this was the date set for the opening of the bids for the grading and construction of approximately 7.65 miles of paved streets, and 9.36 miles of concrete sidewalk, as per advertisement for bids, published July 25, August 1 and 8, known as L.
