ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

Sealed proposals for the construction of a Public Swimming Pool addressed to the Mayor and City Council of Idaho Falls, Idaho, will be received at the City Hall, Idaho Falls, Idaho, until 8:00 P.M. Mountain Standard Time on the 25th day of August, 1954, and then will be publicly opened and read.

The work contemplated consists of the construction of a reinforced concrete swimming pool, masonry type bath house, and a filter building including water treating equipment.

The swimming pool will be 135 feet in length and 54 feet wide and surrounded by a concrete deck 16 feet, 8 inches wide. The bath house is to have a concrete floor, masonry walls, and flat wood roof. The filter building will be of both reinforced concrete and masonry construction. The filter building will house two gravity type filters, two vertical turbine type pumps and a horizontal centrifugal pump, chlorine metering equipment and steam boiler pool heating facilities.

Plans and specifications may be examined at the office of the City Recorder, City Hall, Idaho Falls, Idaho, or at the office of Cornell, Howland, Hayes and Merryfield, 1600 Western Avenue, Cornwallis, Oregon, or 222 Idaho Building, Boise, Idaho. Copies of the Contract Documents may be obtained at the above offices upon a deposit of Forty Dollars (40.00). the full amount of the deposit will be refunded if the said Plans and Specifications are returned in good condition within fifteen (15) days after the date of the bid opening. Additional copies of

said documents may be obtained at the above offices upon a deposit of thirty Dollars (\$30.00) for each additional copy; Twelve Dollars (\$12.00) of which be refunded if said additional copies are returned in good condition within fifteen (15) days after the date of bid opening.

Each proposal must be submitted on the prescribed form and accompanied by a certified check, cashier's check, or bid bond payable to the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, in an amount not less than five per cent (5%) of the amount bid.

The successful bidder will be required to furnish security for faithful performance of the contract in the full amount of the contract price. the right is reserved to reject any and all proposals, to postpone the award of the contract for a period not to exceed thirty (30) days and to accept such proposals as are to the best interest of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho.
