

DECEMBER 17, 1954

The City Council of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, met in Regular Session December 17, 1954, at 8 P.M. in the Council Chambers at Idaho Falls, Idaho. Present: E. W. Fanning, Mayor; Councilmen Freeman, Foote, Rogers, and Petersen;. Also present: S. R. Rostad, City Clerk; T. R. Peters, Purchasing Agent; Arthur L. Smith, City Attorney; C. R. Black, City Engineer.

The minutes of a Meeting held on December 8, 1954, were read and approved.

Mr. Gilbert St. Clair, representing Dr. Paul, Dr. Call, and George Bitter, appeared before the Council, protesting the annexation of tracts of land, owned by the above parties, calling the Councils attention to Idaho Code 1CA50-303 and the Supreme Court's decision, Case 41-294, Boise City versus Boise Development Co.

Mr. Raymond H. Holmes and Sidney Ralph, appeared before the Council, objecting to the erection of service station on John Adams Parkway, by Grant Earl.

Gentlemen:

We, your Street Committee and City Engineer, have inspected that portion of the alley through Block 15, of Dwight's Addition to the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, between the Yellowstone Highway and Lee Avenue.

On December 6, 1954, C. S. Oden and Leonard A. Wright, submitted a request to the City to close that portion of the alley between the east side of Lot 39, Block 15, Dwight's Addition and Yellowstone Avenue.

The City has an 8 inch sewer line in this alley which extends from Lee Avenue to Boulevard. There is also the City power line and the Mountain States telephone line in this alley.

Mr. Oden has built garages across the alley adjacent to his property, and the Bonneville Lumber Co. have built fences across the alley adjacent to their property, thus the alley is physically closed at the present time.

Due to the public use of the alley by public utilities and the probable use for business development in the future we recommend that the petition be denied.
