The City Council of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, met in Regular Session, May 21, 1954, at 8 P.M. in the Council Chambers at Idaho Falls, Idaho. Present: E. W. Fanning, Mayor; Councilmen Petersen, Freeman, Foote and Rogers. Also present: S. R. Rostad, City Clerk; T. R. Peters, Purchasing Agent; A. L. Smith, City Attorney; C. R. Black, City Engineer.

The minutes of Meeting held on May 7, 1954, were read and approved.

**RESOLUTION**

WHEREAS, by Resolution duly passed and approved the 7<sup>th</sup> day of May 1954, the City Council of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, agreed and resolved to sell at public auction on the 21<sup>st</sup> day of May 1954, the hereinafter described real property owned by said City and not used or needed for public purposes, for cash in an amount not less than the appraised value of said property, which real property is situate in Bonneville County, Idaho, and described as follows, to-wit;

The west Six (6) feet of Lot Two (2), Block Eight (8), Railroad Addition to the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, as per the recorded plat thereof.

WHEREAS, by said Resolution three disinterested freeholders of said City were duly selected and appointed to appraise said property and determine its value, and said appraisers so appointed duly appraised said property at the value of \$1,482.00;

WHEREAS, notice of the sale of said property by public auction was duly published for at least ten (10) days in the official paper of said City, to-wit: the Post Register, as appears by affidavit on file in the office of the City Clerk of said City; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to said notice said auction sale was duly held and conducted by the City Clerk on the front steps of the City Hall, in the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, on the 21<sup>st</sup> day of May, 1954, at 10:00 o'clock A.M. of said day; and Safeway Stores Incorporated, a Corporation, was the highest and best bidder at said sale, having bid the amount of \$1,482.00 for said property.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF IDAHO FALLS, IDAHO, that the Mayor of said City be, and he is, hereby authorized and directed to execute and deliver on behalf of said City a deed to said property conveying title to said property to Safeway Stores Incorporated, a Corporation.

### NOTICE OF CLAIM FOR DAMAGES

To the City of Idaho Falls and the City Clerk of the City of Idaho Falls, Bonneville County, Idaho;

Take notice that in accordance with the provisions of Section 50-162 of the Idaho Code, I, Rose Cleverly, hereby present you with my claim for damages against the City with the information required to be given under said section as follows:

1. That the injury for which I claim damages against the City occurred on the 3<sup>rd</sup> day of April, 1954, at approximately 10:30 P.M.
2. The place of injury was the point where the sidewalk meets the curbing abutting Park Avenue and Broadway in the City of Idaho Falls, Bonneville County, Idaho.
3. The character and manner of such injury and the facts concerned therewith are as follows: I was just preparing to enter the crosswalk on Park Avenue when the heel of my left shoe caught in a hole or indenture in the sidewalk. This hole was of sharp depth as compared to the regular surface around it. I was wearing low heeled shoes. Upon my heel catching in this irregular crevice I fell violently to the ground wrenching and spraining my right ankle and causing numerous bruises on my body. I also received an abrasion on my left forearm and a sprained little finger on my left hand. The injuries thus received have caused me to seek medical attention and the accompanying discomfiture and pain have kept me from performing my usual duties.
4. The said fall and injuries were caused by the hole and irregular surface of the said crosswalk.
5. The amount of damages claimed by reason of such injury is \$1,000.00.
