The City Council of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, met in Regular Session, May 7th, 1954 at 8 P.M. in the Council Chambers at Idaho Falls, Idaho. Present: E. W. Fanning, Mayor; Councilmen Petersen, Freeman, Foote and Rogers. Also present: S. R. Rostad, City Clerk; T. R. Peters, Purchasing Agent; A. L. Smith, City Attorney; C. R. Black, City Engineer.

Dear Sir:

In connection with our Rail-Trailer Program, it will be necessary for us to use 123 feet of the east end of that area you are now using just east and north of our freight house. This area is now covered by Lease L & T 13736.

Our Rail-Trailer Program starts the 1st of June, and it will be necessary that we have this area before that time. At the present time there is a fence constructed paralleling our main line. It will be necessary for you to remove this 123 feet portion, and I am wondering if you could re-locate this portion so as to keep people from parking in the area that we will be using.

I realize that this is less time than our usual thirty day notification but this program has taken us more or less by surprise, and it is necessary to act immediately.
