The City Council of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, met in Recessed Session March 8, 1954, at 8 P.M. in the Council Chambers at Idaho Falls, Idaho. Present: E. W. Fanning, Mayor; Councilmen Rogers, Petersen and Foote. Absent: Freeman. Also present: S. R. Rostad, City Clerk; T. R. Peters, Purchasing Agent; Arthur L. Smith, City Attorney.
