

FEBRUARY 19, 1954

The City Council of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, met in Regular Session on February 19, 1954, at 8 P.M. in the Council Chambers at Idaho Falls, Idaho. Present: E. W. Fanning, Mayor; Councilmen Freeman, Foote and Petersen. Absent, Councilman Rogers. Also present: S. R. Rostad, City Clerk; T. R. Peters, Purchasing Agent; Arthur L. Smith, City Attorney; C. R. Black, City Engineer.

The minutes of Meeting held on February 5th, were read and approved.

The report for the month of January, by H. P. Hill, Manager of the Airport, was read. There being no objection the report was ordered placed on file.

The following license applications were presented, to-wit: Boyd J. Emery, Electrical Contractor; Bruce Wheeler, Electrical Contractor; Journeyman Electricians: Bruce Wheeler, Marshall D. Rapp, Truman L. Wilson, Stanley Helm, and Charles W. Bateman. It was moved by Councilman Foote and seconded by Freeman, that the above licenses be granted. Roll call resulted as follows: Yes, 3; No, None; Carried.

It was moved by Councilman Freeman and seconded by Foote, that account #B-76, Alaska Bar, c/o Dean Packer, in the amount of \$744.85, be charged off and the Clerk is hereby instructed to issue credit to balance the account. Roll call resulted as follows: Yes, Councilmen Petersen, Freeman, and Foote; No, None; Absent, Rogers; Carried.

It was moved by Councilman Freeman and seconded by Petersen, that lease ACE No. 9036, Audit No. 7348, covering highway on right of way, be cancelled; the above not now used for highway purposes. Roll call resulted as follows: Yes, 3; No, None; Absent, Rogers; Carried.

ORDINANCE NO. 833

AN ORDINANCE DECLARING MOTOR VEHICLES UNLAWFULLY PARKED UPON THE STREETS, ALLEYS, SIDEWALKS AND COMMONS OF THE CITY OF IDAHO FALLS TO BE UNLAWFUL OBSTRUCTIONS; PROVIDING THAT MOTOR VEHICLES UNLAWFULLY SO PARKED MAY BE MOVED OR TOWED AWAY AND PLACED IN A SUITABLE PLACE OF STORAGE BY, OR UNDER THE DIRECTION OF THE CHIEF OF POLICE; PROVIDING THAT ANY SENTENCE IMPOSED UPON ANY PERSON CHARGED WITH AN

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OFFENSE INVOLVING PARKING OF A MOTOR VEHICLE IN THE CITY OF IDAHO FALLS MAY BE SUSPENDED OR COMMUTED BY THE POLICE JUDGE, AND SETTING FORTH THE CONDITIONS THEREFORE; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES AND PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH; PROVIDING WHEN THE ORDINANCE SHALL BECOME EFFECTIVE.

The foregoing Ordinance was read by the City Clerk. It was moved by Councilman Petersen, seconded by Foote, that the provisions of Section 50-2004 of the Idaho Code requiring all Ordinances to be fully and distinctly read on three several days be dispensed with. The question being, "SHALL THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION 50-2004 OF THE IDAHO CODE REQUIRING ALL ORDINANCES TO BE READ ON THREE SEVERAL DAYS BE DISPENSED WITH?" Roll call as follows: Ayes, Freeman, Foote and Petersen; No, None; Absent, Rogers. The majority of all the members of the Council present having voted in the affirmative, the Mayor declared the rule dispensed with and ordered the Ordinance placed before the Council for final consideration the question being, "SHALL THE ORDINANCE PASS?" Roll call as follows: Ayes, Freeman, Foote and Petersen; No, None; Absent, Rogers. The majority of all the members of the Council having voted in the affirmative, the Mayor declared the Ordinance passed.

It was moved by Councilman Petersen and seconded by Foote, that the Council adjourn; Carried.
