The City Council of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, met in Regular Session on November 20, 1953, at 8 P.M. in the Council Chambers at Idaho Falls, Idaho. Present: E. W. Fanning, Mayor; Councilmen Foote, Rogers and Petersen; Absent, Councilman Freeman. Also present: S. R. Rostad, City Clerk; T. R. Peters, Purchasing Agent; Arthur L. Smith, City Attorney; C. R. Black, City Engineer.

The minutes of a Meeting held on November 6, 1953, were read and approved.

The following letter from Robert F. Johnson & Associates, Inc., was received.

Re: Changing a Street name from
Sherman Place to Royal Place

Gentlemen:

We respectfully request a change of name of a short cul-de-sac Street in South Bel-Aire Division #2 from Sherman Place to Royal Place. This Street lies south of Lovejoy Street and connects with Royal Avenue.

All other cul-de-sac streets in Bel-Aire have been given names corresponding to the street with which they connect. Since this particular one connects with Royal Avenue, we feel that the name "Royal Place" would keep our system of street names more uniform. It would make it easier for the Fire Department, Postal Department, delivery trucks and service cars to find it.

Upon the advice of Mr. Smith the City Attorney, we are submitting this request for your approval.

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, heretofore by virtue of proceedings had and conducted in creating and establishing Local Improvement District No. 22 for the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, an excessive and inequitable assessment in the amount of \$2,664.00 was made and levied against the real property hereinafter described; and

WHEREAS, said assessment should have been made and levied in the amount of \$1,332.00, being one-half the amount actually made and levied; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Mayor and Council of the City of Idaho Falls to give the owner of said real property relief from said excessive assessment insofar as the granting of relief from the same shall not impair the payment, promptly when due, of the bonds heretofore issued in said District, and insofar as the granting of relief from the same shall be in no wise unlawful;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF IDAHO FALLS, as follows:

That the assessment heretofore made and levied in Local Improvement District No. 22 for Idaho Falls, Idaho, against the following described lands in Bonneville County, Idaho, to-wit:

Lots One (1) and Two (2), Block One (1), Edgewater Heights Addition to the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, as per the recorded plat thereof,

be, and the same is hereby reduced from \$2,664.00 to \$1,332.00, and the reduced amount shall be payable as in the following paragraph set forth.

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Treasurer, however, shall collect the assessment levied and assessed against said property in manner provided by law at the time and in the manner as the same are presently levied and assessed until the principal amount of \$1,332.00 is paid, at which time all subsequent assessments shall be cancelled if such cancellation shall not affect the payment of the bonds in said District.
