The City Council of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, met in Regular Session on October 16, 1953, at 8 P.M. in the Council Chambers at Idaho Falls, Idaho. Present: E. W. Fanning, Mayor; Councilmen Petersen, Freeman, and Foote. Also present: S. R. Rostad, City Clerk; T. R. Peters, Purchasing Agent; Arthur L. Smith, City Attorney; C. R. Black, City Engineer. Absent, Councilman Rogers.

The minutes of Meeting held on Thursday October 8, 1953, were read and approved.

The following petition signed by 32 taxpayers, was read by the City Clerk:

The undersigned taxpayers hereby petition Mayor Fanning and the Idaho Falls City Council to lay a standard macadam road on South Boulevard from 25<sup>th</sup> Street to the paving at the entrance to Hughes Addition, and along Park Road to a suitable stopping place in Tautphaus Park. This project should be considered in the present planning for completion in 1954.

Mr. Cyril Slansky and others spoke in behalf of the above proposed paving. After some discussion the petition was referred to the Engineering Department for study.

The meat inspection report and the Street Commissioners report for the month of September was read by the Clerk. There being no objections the reports were ordered placed on file.

It was moved by Councilman Freeman and seconded by Petersen, that the application for Bartender permit by Devoe Swafford be granted. Roll call resulted as follows: Yes, 3; No, None; Absent, Rogers; Carried.

A letter of October 12<sup>th</sup>, from the Parkinson Tractor Co., regarding leasing or purchasing of Block 12, Dwight's, was read. It was referred to the Parks Committee for study.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE BUILDING CODE OF THE CITY OF IDAHO FALLS, IDAHO; PROVIDING REGULATIONS AND STANDARDS FOR THE INSTALLATION AND MAINTENANCE OF OUTSIDE TELEVISION AND RADIO RECEIVING ANTENNA.

The foregoing Ordinance was read by the City Clerk. It was moved by Councilman Freeman, seconded by Foote, that the above Ordinance be passed on its first treading. Roll call resulted as follows: Yes, Councilmen Petersen, Freeman, and Foote; No, None; Absent, Rogers; Carried.

Mrs. Bert R. Kramer, 1040 Lovejoy Street, appeared before the Council, regarding fencing of canals in the City of Idaho Falls.

Petition by Grant Packer, Jr., 13<sup>th</sup> & Holmes, for rezoning Lot 10 and ½ of Lot 11, Block 25, Scotts Addition, from R-1 to C Limited was read. The Mayor referred the petition to the Board of Adjustments.

Application for light and water assistance by Laura Wellard, 365 E. 18<sup>th</sup> Street, was referred to the Finance Committee.
