

JUNE 19, 1953

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The City Council of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, met in regular session on June 19, 1953, at 8 P.M. in the Council Chambers at Idaho Falls, Idaho. Present: E. W. Fanning, Mayor; Councilmen Petersen, Freeman, Foote. Also present: S. R. Rostad, City Clerk; T. R. Peters, Purchasing Agent; C. R. Black, Engineer. Absent, Councilman John B. Rogers.

The minutes of Meeting held on June 8, 1953, were read and approved.

Captain Oliver of the National Guard appeared before the Council, regarding Lease, and the matter of heating unit for the Administration Building at Tautphaus Park. After some discussion the matter was referred to the Finance Committee and City Engineer for study.

Mr. Lloyd Benton presented to the Council a plat on El Rancho Addition and John Adams Heights Division #3 and asked that the plats be accepted.

It was moved by Councilman Petersen and seconded by Freeman, that the plats be accepted contingent with the approval of the Planning Board. On roll call voting Yes, Councilmen Petersen Freeman and Foote; Nay, None; Absent, Rogers.

The following applications for licenses were presented, to-wit: Del Clark, Dive Inn, 330 1<sup>st</sup>, Soft Drink; and Eugene Stowell, Stowell Dairy, Milk Dealer. It was moved by Councilman Petersen and seconded by Freeman, that the above licenses be granted. On roll call, voting Aye, Petersen, Freeman, and Foote; Nay, None; Absent, Rogers.

Beginning at a point that is N. 53° 22' 30" W. 5.00 feet from the Northeast corner of Lot 5, Block 16, Linden Park Addition Division No. 4 to the City of Idaho Falls, as shown on the recorded plat thereof, and running thence N. 36° 37' 30" E. 5.00 feet; thence N. 53° 22' 30" W. 93.82 feet to a point on a curve with a radius of 635.00 feet; thence Southerly along said curve 10.00
