

MAY 15, 1953

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The City Council of the City of Idaho Falls, met in Regular Session on May 15<sup>th</sup>, 1953, at eight o'clock P.M. Present at said Meeting were Mayor E. W. Fanning; Councilmen Petersen, Freeman, Foote and Rogers. Absent: None. Also present: Claude Black, City Engineer; Arthur L. Smith, City Attorney; T. R. Peters, Purchasing Agent.

The Clerk read the minutes of the previous Meeting held on May 6<sup>th</sup> which were unanimously approved as read.

Mrs. Virginia Blackburn presented a revised plat plan which will include the proposed medical office buildings of Russell A Fogg, druggist. This new plan would eliminate the proposed Flora Circle and be replaced by ranch style units to accommodate doctor's offices and pharmacy. The matter was referred to the Street Committee and City Engineer.

Mr. Roberts of the Phillips Petroleum Company requested that the Council allow the Phillips Company to increase the driveway width for the new Phillips Service Station at Third Street and Holmes Avenue from thirty feet to thirty-eight feet. The Council granted the permission after Roberts said a nearby service station had the same width of driveway entrance.

The following applications for Bartender permits were read: Kenneth Bowcutt, Hub Bar; Kenneth Mepper, Topper Club; Leonard Messmer, Topper Club; Stewart McClure, White Horse Bar; Charles R. Jachetta, Topper Club; Tom Sloan, Jacks Club; Melvin J. Brower, Russett Bar; Robert G. Newman, Bon Villa Club; Harry W. Parker, 251 Broadway; S. C. Montague, Jacks Chicken Inn.

Application for Soft Drink license, signed by Minnie Poorman was also read. It was moved by Freeman and seconded by Rogers, that the applications be granted and that the Clerk issue the necessary permits and licenses to cover same. Roll call voting Aye, Petersen, Freeman, Foote and Rogers; Nay, None.

The following Resolution was read:

### RESOLUTION

"WHEREAS, heretofore by virtue of proceedings had in creating and establishing Local Improvement District No. 23 for a sewer for the City of Idaho Falls, a levy was made and assessed erroneously in the sum of EIGHT HUNDRED FIFTY AND NO/00 (\$850.00) DOLLARS against the following described lands lying and being in Bonneville County, Idaho, and described more particularly as follows, to-wit:

Lots Fifteen (15) and Sixteen (16) Block Sixty-two (62), Highland Park Addition to the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, per the recorded plat thereof; and,

WHEREAS, it appears that said levy and assessment against said property in the amount of EIGHT HUNDRED FIFTY AND NO/100 DOLLARS (\$850.00), should be, and ought to have been, in the sum of FOUR HUNDRED TWENTY-FIVE AND NO/100 (\$425.00) DOLLARS, was made and assessed by reason of an error in the compiling of descriptions and improvements in the proceedings creating and establishing said District;

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NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that FOUR HUNDRED TWENTY-FIVE (\$425.00) DOLLARS of said levy and assessment against said property be cancelled and that the Treasurer of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, be, and she is hereby authorized and directed to make all appropriate entries and corrections in the records pertaining to said District to carry out the cancellation of said excessive portion of said levy as in this said Resolution directed."

It was moved by Freeman, seconded by Rogers that the Resolution be adopted as read. Roll call voting Aye, Foote, Rogers, Petersen, Freeman; Nay, None.

A claim for damages signed by Anne Bridges was read. The matter was referred to the City Attorney.

It was moved by Foote, and seconded by Freeman that an easement be granted to the Northwest Butane Gas Company to install a pipeline from the railroad down Crow Street and across Holmes Avenue to their property located on the Yellowstone Highway. Roll voting Aye, Petersen, Freeman, Foote and Rogers; Nay, None.

A letter from the Clyde Beatty Circus requesting the cancellation of license in the sum of \$100.00 which had been previously paid for a one day showing in Idaho Falls, and asking that the license fee be refunded, was read. It was moved by Freeman, seconded by Petersen that the Clerk be authorized to issue a check in the amount of \$100.00 and mail to the said circus. Roll call voting Aye, Freeman, Foote, Rogers, and Petersen; Nay, None.

It was moved by Foote and seconded by Rogers, that Russell Freeman be appointed President of the City Council for the coming fiscal year. Roll call voting Aye, Foote, Rogers and Petersen; Not voting, Freeman; Nay, None. Motion carried.

A Motion was made and seconded that the Meeting adjourn, which motion was carried unanimously.
