

NOVEMBER 21, 1952

The City Council of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, met in Regular Session on November 21, 1952, at 8 P.M. in the Council Chambers at Idaho Falls, Idaho. Present: E. W. Fanning, Mayor; Councilmen Rogers, Johnson, Freeman and Foote. Also present: S. R. Rostad, City Clerk; T. R. Peters, Purchasing Agent; Arthur L. Smith, City Attorney; C. R. Black, City Engineer.

The minutes of Meeting held on November 7, 1952, were read and approved.

Application for Journeyman Electrician license, by Loyale Babbitt, 561 Gladstone, was presented by the City Clerk. It was moved by Councilman Johnson and seconded by Foote, that the above license be granted. On roll call voting Yes, 4; No, None; Carried.

It was moved by Councilman Freeman and seconded by Johnson, that the old service account in the amount of \$82.75 be charged off and the City Clerk is hereby authorized to issue the proper credit.
