ORDINANCE NO. 803

AN ORDINANCE GRANTING TO THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF IDAHO FALLS, IDAHO THE POWER OF DIRECT LEGISLATION THROUGH THE INITIATIVE AND REFERENDUM, AND THE POWER TO RECALL THE HOLDER OF ANY ELECTIVE OFFICE IN SAID CITY: PROVIDING FOR VOLUNTARY REFERENDUM UPON COUNCIL'S OWN MOTION: PROVIDING FOR THE FORM AND SUFFICIENCY OF PETITIONS AND THE PROCEDURE FOR INSTITUTING THE INITIATIVE REFERENDUM AND RECALL: PROVIDING FOR THE HOLDING OF SPECIAL ELECTIONS: TO SUBMIT ORDINANCES AND MEASURES TO THE VOTERS OF SAID CITY: PROVIDING FOR THE FORM OF THE BALLOTS AND ALL OTHER PROCEDURES FOR SUBMITTING TO THE VOTERS OF SAID CITY MEASURES AND ORDINANCES AT SUCH ELECTIONS: ESTABLISHING THE REQUIRED PERCENTAGE OF AFFIRMATIVE VOTES TO ENACT INITIATIVE AND REFERENDUM MEASURES AND TO RECALL: AND PROVIDING THE EFFECT OF SUCCESSFUL RECALL.

It was moved by Councilman Freeman and seconded by Rogers, that the above Ordinance numbered 803, be passed upon its third and final reading. On roll call voting Yes, Councilmen Foote, Rogers, Johnson and Freeman; No, None; Carried.

WHEREAS, the City Engineer and Committee on Streets have heretofore made out and certified to the City Council, as provided by law, an Assessment Roll of Local Improvement District No. 22.

“AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE PAYMENT OF THE COSTS AND EXPENSES OF CREATING LOCAL IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NO. 22 IN THE CITY OF IDAHO FALLS, IDAHO, AND OF MAKING LOCAL IMPROVEMENTS THEREIN, EXCLUSIVE OF THE COST AND EXPENSES OF IMPROVEMENTS WITHIN STREET INTERSECTIONS, BY INSTALLMENTS PAYABLE IN TEN EQUAL ANNUAL PAYMENTS AS NEARLY AS MAY BE, AND AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF LOCAL IMPROVEMENTS, AND FIXING THE RATE OF INTEREST THEY SHALL BEAR AND MAKING THE SAME PAYABLE ANNUALLY.”

and moved that the Ordinance be adopted and passed by the Council on its first reading. Motion was seconded by Councilman Rogers and the same being put to a vote, was unanimously carried by the affirmative vote of the Mayor and all Councilmen present.

It was moved by Councilman Freeman that the rules be suspended and that the Ordinance be placed on its second and third reading. Motion was seconded by Councilman Rogers, and the same being put to a vote, was unanimously carried by the affirmative vote of the Mayor and all the Councilmen present.

It was moved by Councilman Freeman, seconded by Rogers, that the Ordinance pass its second reading, and the same put to a vote, was carried unanimously by the affirmative vote of the Mayor and all Councilmen present.

It was moved by Councilman Freeman that the Ordinance pass its third reading, and that the same be adopted, and the Clerk be instructed to publish the same as required by law, seconded by Councilman Rogers, and the same being put to a vote, it was unanimously carried, the vote being as follows: “Ayes” Councilmen Freeman, Rogers, Johnson and Foote; “Nay”, None. Whereupon the Mayor declared the motion carried.
