

OCTOBER 3, 1952

The City Council of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, met in Regular Session on October 3, 1952, at 8 P.M. in the Council Chambers at Idaho Falls, Idaho. Present: E. W. Fanning, Mayor; Councilmen Rogers, Johnson, Freeman and Foote. Also present: S. R. Rostad, City Clerk; T. R. Peters, Purchasing Agent and C. R. Black, City Engineer.

The minutes of Meeting held on September 19th, were read and approved.

The Mayor announced that this was the date set to hear protests against the Assessment Roll, L.I.D. No. 22, the protests would now be heard. The following named persons were present and entered oral protests on the width of the proposed street paving; Nels G. Strom, 780 I Street, Edgewater Heights; Abner C. Snarr, 784 I Street, Edgewater Heights; Parley P. Jensen, 766 I Street, Riverside Addition, and R. V. Harding, 756 I Street, Riverside. They informed the Council that they did not protest against 36' pavement; curb to curb.

S. ½ of Block 1 and all of Block 4, South Lawn Addition, all of Block 55 Crows Addition, and that portion of the Assessment abutting the High School property at Holmes Avenue and Seventh Street which would include the cost of improvements on Seventh Street, and Wabash Avenue.
