The City Council of City of Idaho Falls, met in Recessed Session on August 29, 1952 at 8 P.M. in the Council Chambers at Idaho Falls, Idaho. Present: E. W. Fanning, Mayor; Councilmen Foote and Johnson. Absent: Councilmen Freeman and Rogers. Also present: S. R. Rostad, City Clerk; Claude R. Black, City Engineer.

The following Bartenders Permits (applications) were presented by the City Clerk, to-wit:

It was moved by Councilman Johnson and seconded by Foote, that the above applications be granted and the City Clerk is hereby instructed to issue the proper cards. On roll call voting Aye, Johnson and Foote; Nay, None. Absent, Rogers and Freeman; motion carried.

The application for Roller Skating Rink License, July 1 to September 30, 1952, by Thea O. Benson, 295 S. Eastern Avenue, was presented. It was moved by Councilman Foote and seconded by Johnson, that the above license be granted. On roll call voting Aye, Johnson and Foote; Nay, None; Absent, Freeman and Rogers; motion carried.

It was moved by Councilman Foote and seconded by Johnson, that the estimate numbered 2, Airport Lighting Contract, CAA Project No. 9-10-060-202, Idaho Falls Municipal Airport, in the amount of \$7,869.48, by Thompson Electric Services, Salt Lake City, Utah, be allowed and the Clerk is authorized to issue warrant in payment of same. On roll call voting Aye, Johnson and Foote; Nay None; Absent, Freeman and Rogers; motion carried.

The Mayor announced that this was the date set for hearing written protests against the assessment roll on Local Improvement District No. 23, as per notice published August 15<sup>th</sup> and 17<sup>th</sup>, 1952; no written protests were filed and no oral protests were presented at the Meeting against the assessment roll on Local Improvement District No. 23. The Mayor ordered the Meeting recessed to 8 P.M. September 5, 1952, for further consideration on protests against L. I. D. No. 23.
