

AUGUST 15, 1952

The City Council of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, met in Regular Session on August 15, 1952, at 8 P.M. in the Council Chambers at Idaho Falls, Idaho. Present: E. W. Fanning, Mayor; Councilmen Rogers, Johnson and Freeman; Absent: Foote. Also present: S. R. Rostad, City Clerk; T. R. Peters, Purchasing Agent; Arthur L. Smith, City Attorney; Claude R. Black, City Engineer.

The minutes of Meeting held on August 7, 1952, were read and approved.

The application for light and water assistance by Eliza Madsen was presented and referred to the Finance Committee.

The following Ordinances were presented: Recall and Initiative and Referendum; after some discussion, it was moved by Councilman Rogers and seconded by Freeman, that the above Ordinances be tabled. On roll call voting Aye, 3; Nay, None; Absent, one; carried.

ORDINANCE NUMBER 801

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING EIGHT (8) ELECTION PRECINCTS IN THE CITY OF IDAHO FALLS, IDAHO; DESIGNATING THE SAME BY NUMBER; AND WARD; AND PARTICULARLY SETTING FORTH THE BOUNDARIES OF EACH PRECINCT.

The above Ordinance was read at length by the Clerk. It was moved by Councilman Freeman and seconded by Rogers, that the provisions of Section 50-2004 of the Idaho Code, requiring all Ordinances to be fully and distinctly read on three several days be dispensed with. The question being, "Shall the provisions of Section 50-2004 of the Idaho Code, requiring all Ordinances to be read on three several days be dispensed with?" Roll call resulted as follows: Ayes, Rogers, Johnson and Freeman; Nay, None; Absent, Foote. The majority of the Council having voted in the affirmative, the Mayor declared the rule dispensed with and ordered the Ordinance placed before the Council for final consideration, the question being, "Shall the Ordinance pass?" The majority of all the members of the Council present having voted in the affirmative, the Mayor declared the Ordinance passed.

RESOLUTION

A RESOLUTION FIXING THE TIME WHEN OBJECTIONS TO THE ASSESSMENT ROLL MADE OUT BY THE COMMITTEE ON STREETS OF THE CITY COUNCIL, TOGETHER WITH THE CITY ENGINEER, WILL BE HEARD AND CAUSING SUCH ROLL TO BE FILED IN THE OFFICE OF THE CITY CLERK.

WHEREAS, the Committee on Streets of the City Council of the City of Idaho Falls, together with the City Engineer, has made out an assessment roll for Local Improvement District No. 23 for Sewer, in accordance with the provisions of Ordinance heretofore passed

and approved, and Section 50-2915, Idaho Code, and has certified said roll to said City Council: and

WHEREAS, said City Council has caused said roll to be filed in the office of the City Clerk on the 15th day of August, 1952;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF IDAHO FALLS, IDAHO:

Section 1. That Friday the 29th day of August, 1952, at 8:00 o'clock P.M. at the City Hall in the City of Idaho Falls be, and the same is hereby fixed as the time when the City Council will hear and consider objections to said assessment roll by the parties aggrieved by such assessments.

Section 2. That the City Clerk shall give notice by publication in the official newspaper of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, the Post Register, published daily except Saturday, in two consecutive issues, the last of which to be at least ten days before the said 29th of August, 1952, that such assessment roll is on file in his office, the date of filing the same, and said notice shall state the time at which the Council will hear and consider objections to said assessment roll by the parties aggrieved by such assessments.

Section 3. That the owner or owners of any property which is assessed in such assessment roll, whether named or not in such roll, may, within ten days from the last publication provided for herein, file with the Clerk his objections in writing to said assessment.

Section 4. That all action heretofore taken by said City and the officers of said City directed toward said advertisement be, and the same is hereby ratified, approved and confirmed.
