The City Council of the City of Idaho Falls, met in Recessed Session on July 28, 1952, at 8 P. M. in the Council Chambers at Idaho Falls, Idaho. Present: E. W. Fanning, Mayor; Councilmen Foote, Rogers, and Freeman. Absent, Councilman Johnson. Also present: S. R. Rostad, City Clerk; Arthur L. Smith, City Attorney and Claude R. Black, City Engineer.

The Mayor announced that this was the date set for the opening of the bids for the grading and construction of approximately 7.38 miles of paved streets, and 13.53 miles of concrete sidewalk, as per advertisement for bids, published July 13<sup>th</sup>, 20<sup>th</sup> and 27<sup>th</sup>, known as L. I. D. No. 22. The bids were opened and read as follows, to wit:

The above bids were referred to the Street Committee and City Engineer, for study and to report back to the Council.
