The City Council of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, met in Regular Session on July 18, 1952, at 8 P.M. in the Council Chambers at Idaho Falls, Idaho. Present: E. W. Fanning, Mayor; Councilmen Foote, Rogers, Johnson, and Freeman. Also present: S. R. Rostad, City Clerk; T. R. Peters, Purchasing Agent; and Claude R. Black, City Engineer.

The minutes of Meeting held on July 9, 1952, were read and approved.

The Mayor announced that this was the date set for the opening of the bids for the construction of sub fire station building; the bids were opened and read as follows, to-wit:
